A Sunflower Cottage Crochet Pattern

#SunflowerCottageCrochet

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Materials

- #4 weight cotton of choice. I used part skeins of Drops Paris that I had in my stash.
- 4mm hook
- Stitch markers (optional)
- Scissors

Gauge

This will depend on yarn weight used and hook size. I used 4 weight cotton and 4mm hook to get a gauge of 12sts and 8 rows of HDC in 2"

Sizing

Each individual motif is approximately 4" square. You can add rows and squares to make this table runner as long and as wide as desired!

Abbreviations

- Ch – chain
- Sk – skip
- SC – Single Crochet
- HDC – half double crochet
- BS – Bean Stitch
- DC – Double Crochet
- TC – Treble Crochet
- FO – fasten off

Pattern Notes

- Written in US terms
- This pattern is reversible
- Adjust the size of your table runner by using less squares! You can literally make this as big or small as you would like.
- I recommend joining your motifs in rows so you can keep a track of exactly where you are.
- Where joining when 3 or 4 motifs are touching, I would recommend joining them to the top center corner otherwise the join looks bulky. See figure photos below.

Special Stitches

Bean St – To work this stitch you will:

YO, insert hook into next st, YO and pull through, *YO and insert hook into same st, YO and pull through. Rep from * once more, YO and pull through all 7 loops on hook.

Picot – CH 3, SS into first CH made.

Pattern

For the first Motif:

In Colour A:

Rnd 1: In MR CH1 (does not count) work 6 SC into centre. SS to join. (6)

Rnd 2: CH1 (does not count), [HDC, BS, CH1 (does count as a st)] in each st around, SS to join (18 – 6 HDC, 6 BS, 6 CH1)

In Colour B:

Rnd 3: CH1 (does not count) *[SC, HDC, DC, TC, picot] in first st, [TC, DC, HDC, SC] in next st, ss into next st.* Rep from * to * around. (6 'leaves' and 6 slip stitches)



FO

In Colour C:

Attach yarn to the centre of any picot.

Rnd 4: CH8, SS to the centre of the next picot. Repeat 5 more times.

Rnd 5: SS into first CH8 space, CH1 (does not count) work 10 SC into each CH8 space around.
SS to join. (60 SC)

Rnd 6: CH1, HDC into first st and next 6 sts, *[2HDC, ch2, 2HDC] in next st, HDC in next 14 sts.
Rep from * around until you have worked the last corner, HDC in last 7 sts. SS to join
(64 HDC, 4 CH2 spaces)

FO and weave in ends.

For the second Motif:

Follow Rnds 1-5 as per the first motif.

Rnd 6: CH1, HDC into first st and next 6 sts, *[2HDC, ch2, 2HDC] in next st, HDC in next 14 sts.
Rep from * 2 more times.

To join as you go while working the last corner:

In the next st, work 2HDC, CH 1 then pull your loop longer, remove your hook, insert your hook from the front to the back into the CH2 corner space of the square you are attaching it. Place loop back on hook, pull through and tighten loop. Work the second CH1. Finish the corner by worked 2 HDC into the same st you were working on the second motif. HDC in last 7 sts. SS to join

(64 HDC, 4 CH2 spaces)

This technique is used to join all corners together as you go.

At every corner where you need to join as you go:

Work 2HDC, CH 1 then pull your loop longer, remove your hook, insert your hook from the front to the back into the CH2 corner space of the square you are attaching it. Place loop back on hook, pull through and tighten loop. Work the second CH1. Finish the corner by worked 2 HDC into the same st and continue around.

Border:



Attach yarn to the stitch before any CH2 space at the top of any peak (see Fig Photo below)

Rnd 1: Ch1 (does not count) HDC in first st, *[2HDC, CH2, 2HDC] in ch2 space, HDC in next 19 sts. HDC3tog (this should be the stitch before the very bottom, the bottom st and the next st) HDC in next 19 sts until you reach the CH2 space, repeat from * all of the way around the edge of your runner. SS to join

Rnds 2-3: Rep round 1.

FO and weave in ends.

Block as desired / needed.
