A Sunflower Cottage Crochet Pattern

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Pattern Specifics:

Materials:

- Any 3 weight yarn of your choosing – I used approximately 340 yards of Knit Craft Baby Brilliance DK for my 4-10 size infinity scarf.
- 5mm hook
- Scissors
- Tapestry Needle
- Stitch Markers optional to mark first or last stitch of the row.

Gauge:

Not important for this project – a relaxed tension will work out just fine!

My gauge was 20 sts and 7 rows per 4”

Sizing:

Age 2-3 = 4” x 40”

Age 4-10 = 5” x 50”

Teen = 6.5” x 60”

Adult = 7.5” x 70”

Abbreviations used:

Ch(s)--chain(s)

St(s)--stitch(es)

rep--repeat

dc--double crochet

sc--single crochet

to - repeat between the * and *

FO—fasten off

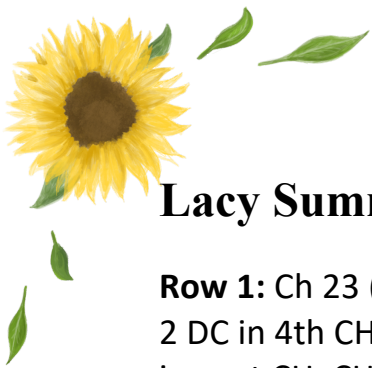
YO—yarn over

Pattern Notes:

- Written in US terms.
- CH1 and CH3 start **do count** as a st unless stated otherwise.
- The stitch multiple for this pattern is 4 +3 for the chain start.
- Where stitch counts differ for sizes they will be written as 2-3 (4-10, teen, adult)

Special stitches:

There are no special stitches in this pattern.



Lacy Summer Infinity Scarf Pattern:

Row 1: Ch 23 (27, 35, 39)

2 DC in 4th CH from hook, CH2, 2DC in next ch, sk2, *2DC in next CH, CH2, 2DC in next CH, sk 2 CH* Rep from * to * across until you have 4 CH left. 2DC in next CH, CH2, 2DC in next CH, sk1, SC in last CH.

Row 2: Ch3, turn, work [2DC, CH2, 2DC] into each CH2 sp across. SC into top of CH3 start from the previous row.

Rows 3 on: Rep row 2 until your work is 40 (50, 60, 70)" long. Leave a long tail and FO.

At this point you can either leave it as a scarf, or sew the ends together using the long tail to create the infinity scarf.

To assemble the infinity scarf, lay your scarf flat, fold it in half along the longest side. Sew the ends together.

Weave in ends.
